We will be decorating the church for Christmas November 27 starting at 10:00 am. There will be trees to put up, garland to hang, wreaths to hang, and so much more.



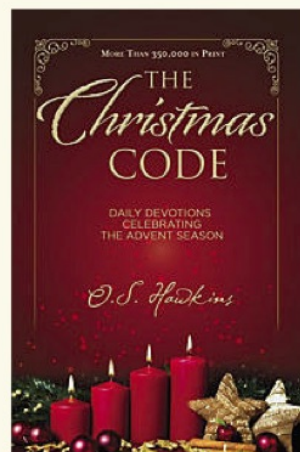
